1. Welcome & apologies:

commitments.

3. Minutes of the previous AGM:

3.1 Confirmation of Minutes

### 3.2 Matters arising:

APYCC investigation ongoing matter affecting Ku Arts board of directors.

Josephine expressed that she would like to see a meeting of just Anangu to come together and talk about this issue.

### Mr Miller's reply to Josephine:

"I have recently said that it is important that we all come together and talk about this issue so that we can move forward and work together, that we can be friends again and share our stories. Like it has been in the old days.

Let's leave it for now and come back together to talk about it soon, we can come together after the investigation and talk about this story – that's my family, that's my people my relations. So, wait because they are looking around now and after we will get together again." – David Miller

### Action:

Danna suggested that Ku Arts set up a separate meeting to discuss this matter. To give directors a chance to discuss this issue in more detail and how to move forward from the matter. It was suggested that the meeting be between only APY Lands members.

"It's important that the boards get together – we will help the Ku Arts boards to meet (just Anangu), we would like to support this once the investigation is finished. I will be led by what the board wants." Melissa - Ku Arts CEO

Rule book changes to:

## 6.14 Payment

A Director cannot be paid a salary for their work as directors, they can however be paid a sitting fee of up to \$200.00 per day for attending general meetings as set in the meeting agenda.

Directors may be paid **otherwise** only if they have a contract to provide goods or services to the Corporation (so long as the director has fulfilled their duty to disclose a conflict as required by this rule book (6.13) and the payment is fair and reasonable to the Corporation. All payments must be reported to the board.

The Corporation may pay the directors' travelling and other expenses for attending meetings or to do with other Corporation business.

After discussion the members agreed to amend the rule book of the corporation as per the below wording (new wording noted in bold):

Directors may be paid fees for attending meetings of the Board and its Committees. The amount of such fees will be established and reviewed by the Board from time to time.

Directors may be paid **otherwise** only if they have a contract to provide goods or services to the Corporation (so long as the director has fulfilled their duty to disclose a conflict as required by this rule book (6.13) and the payment is fair and reasonable to the Corporation. All payments must be reported to the board.

The Corporation may pay the directors' travelling and other expenses for attending meetings or to do with other Corporation business.
